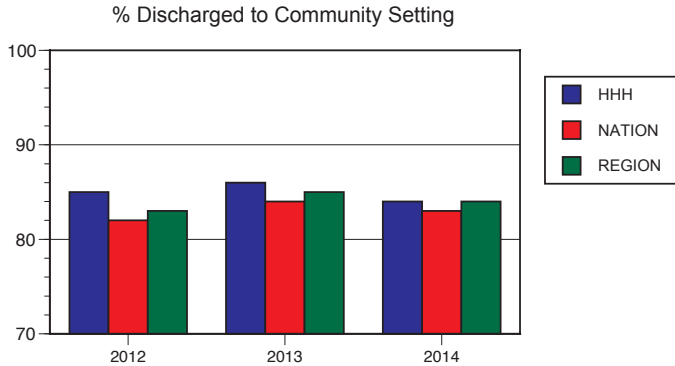
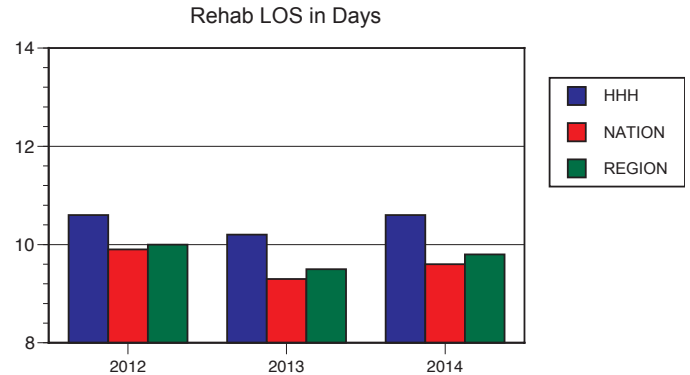


Tracking Outcomes at Helen Hayes Hospital: Cardiac

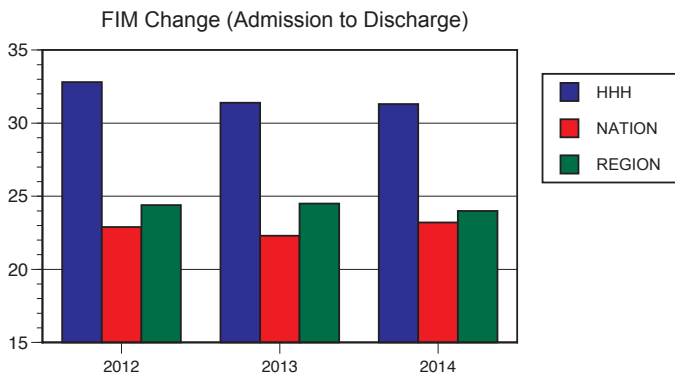

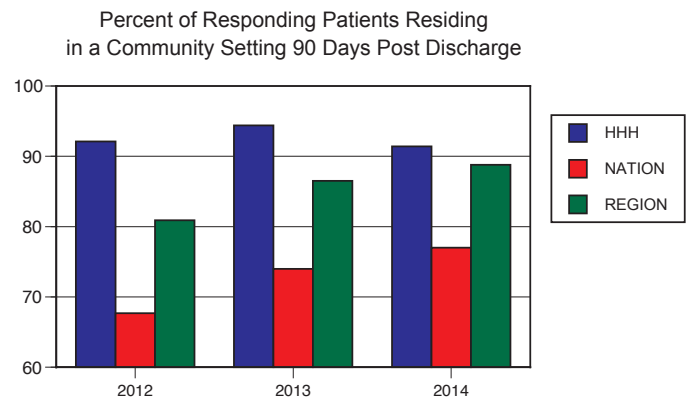
The percent of patients discharged to a community setting remains higher or on par with the nation and region. Discharge support system, living environment and functional status impact the discharge placement. At Helen Hayes Hospital we always discharge a patient safely and optimally to home.



The average length of stay for cardiac patients at Helen Hayes Hospital varies according to their needs. The length of stay is slightly higher than the nation and region, however overall functional outcomes are consistently higher.



Patients' overall functional improvement is consistently higher than the nation and region. Our goal is to assist patients in reaching their optimum level of functioning within acute rehabilitation guidelines. Cardiac patients who receive rehabilitation services at Helen Hayes Hospital make excellent gains.



The above chart indicates that 90 days after discharge, among patients contacted, a higher percent of Helen Hayes Hospital patients are living within a community setting as compared to the nation and region.
