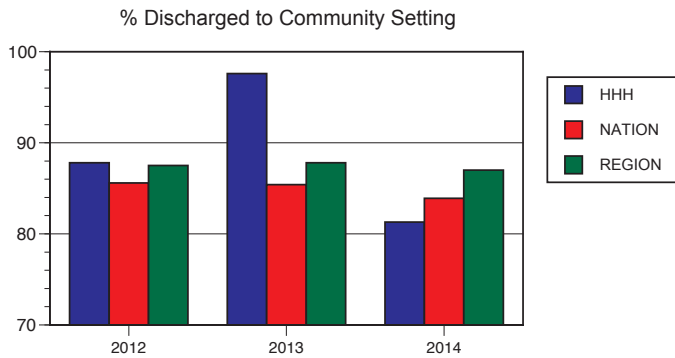
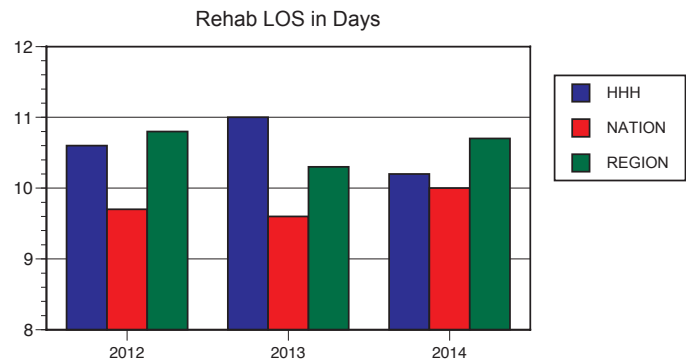


Tracking Outcomes at Helen Hayes Hospital: Pulmonary

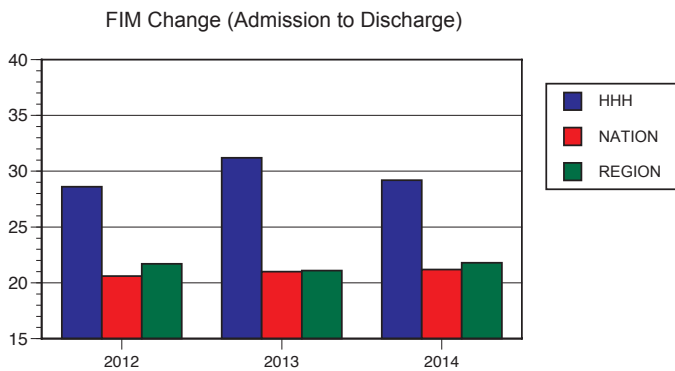

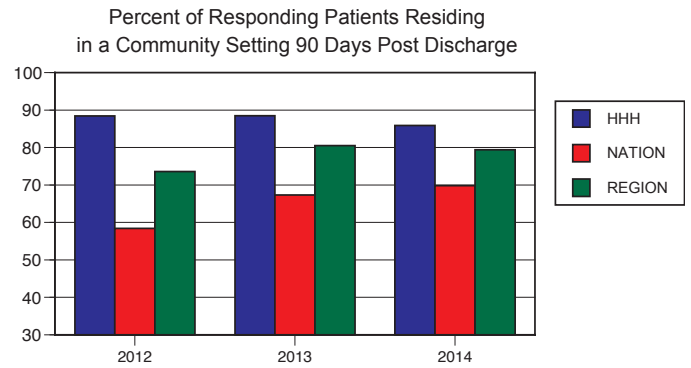
The percent of pulmonary patients discharged to a community remains higher or on par with the nation and the region. The average length of stay for patients at Helen Hayes Hospital varies according to their needs. The length of stay is determined by the progress a patient makes and is shorter or on par with the nation and region.



The pulmonary patients' overall functional improvement is consistently higher than the nation and region. Our goal is to assist patients in reaching their optimum level of functioning within acute rehabilitation guidelines.



The above chart indicates that 90 days after discharge, among patients contacted, a higher percent of Helen Hayes Hospital patients are living within a community setting as compared to the nation and region.
