



## OP Neurology - Disclosure Statement 2017

Helen Hayes Hospital's OP Neurology Program is an individualized yet comprehensive combination therapeutic techniques provided by the professional rehabilitation staff including PT, OT, ST, pool, CRT, P and O, and wellness. The program is designed for persons from infancy through lifespan, recovering from a TBI, SCI, Stroke or other neurologic injury. The admission determination is made after a referral is received from a physician and the therapy team performs their individual assessments. The focus is on mobility, balance, upper and lower extremity motor control, activities of daily living, cognition & memory, exercise & strengthening, speech and language difficulties, perceptual skills, swallowing, adaptive equipment, and pain management. Throughout the patient's stay, the team works to promote optimum independence and well-being. The patient's length of stay is based upon progress, medical necessity, and analysis of the functional gains and goal attainment.

### Purposes of the Program

- To provide individualized yet comprehensive rehabilitation management of the brain injury, SCI, stroke, and other neurologically involved patient through the collaborative efforts of the rehabilitation/therapy staff.
- To provide an individualized plan of treatment designed to improve the patient towards his/her maximal physical, mental, social and speech potential.
- To provide education to the patient and caregivers regarding all aspects of rehab management during and post therapy.
- To facilitate discharge planning and community integration by providing information about diagnosis specific community resources available to the patient and caregivers.
