

Inpatient Subacute Rehabilitation Unit Patient Outcomes 2021

Located in New York's Hudson River Valley, Helen Hayes Hospital primarily serves patients from throughout the New York Metropolitan region and also attracts patients from across the country.

In 2021, the Subacute Rehabilitation Unit treated 144 residents, who ranged in age from 36 - 97. The average length of stay was 16 days.

The Hospital's Subacute Rehabilitation Unit offers an expanded level of service

to patients in need of short-term rehabilitation care and/or skilled nursing services before returning home. Subacute rehab is well suited for individuals who may not be medically able to participate in full-day, intensive therapy, such as those with orthopedic injuries, who are not yet weight-bearing, as well as individuals recovering from hip or knee surgery, general surgical procedures, or those who are medically deconditioned.

Treatment goals may include:

Walking

Climbing stairs independently

Regaining strength and endurance


Managing daily routines, such as bathing/dressing
